Justice, Not Politics

Philadelphia students continue to be shortchanged in terms of school funding.

The top 100 school districts spend on average, \$2,709 more per student, than the Philadelphia school district does.

That means that over 12 years of education, the average Philadelphia Student gets 3 years worth of schooling less than students in those high performing high spending schools.

This also means that, in a classroom of thirty students, the gap between the average spending of the top 100 districts and the Philadelphia school district is \$81,270, more than enough to pay for another teacher.

Below is the chart showing for each individual school in Philadelphia how much more it would have available to spend at that school for smaller class sizes, art and music programs, advanced placement classes, guidance counselors, science labs, etc if they were funded as well as the average top 100 districts. *
