THE TEAM

- You **MUST** apply as a team.
- Teams should include: regular & special education teacher, administrator & parent whose team goal is to more fully include the student.
- Teams are required to complete an Inclusion Action Project.
- 15 school teams from Eastern Pennsylvania will be selected to participate.

THE SESSIONS

- Seven sessions are offered: 4 sessions for full teams plus 3 sessions for parents only.
- **THERE IS NO CHARGE TO ATTEND.**
- **PARTICIPANTS MUST ATTEND ALL SESSIONS.**

Plus:

- * Reimbursement for travel and childcare costs
- * Overnight lodging (if traveling more than 40 Miles)
- * Meals provided
- * Act 48 credits available (for a \$10 fee)
- * Graduate credit may be available (fees apply).
- * PDE mini-grants may be available to support teams.
